41 Percent of children were low-income or living in poverty



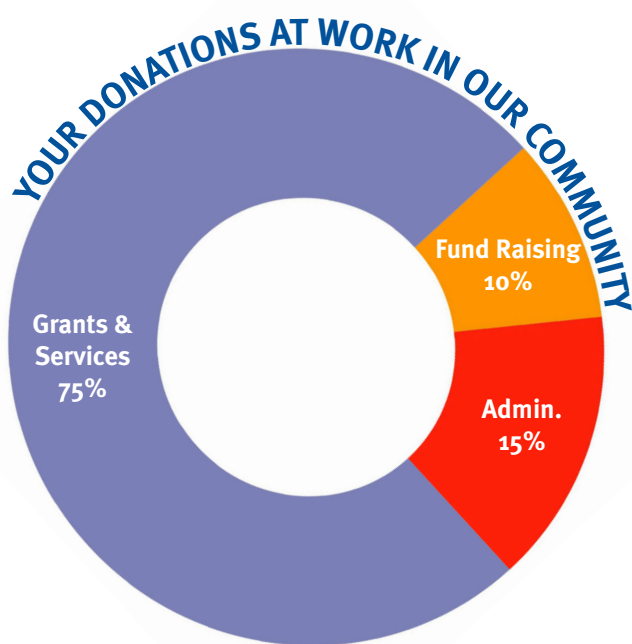
20 Percent of adults were uninsured

- **16,515** hours of care for senior citizens
